


The above statement was devised by the United Irish Societies in connection with the celebration of Detroit's Tri-Centennial. Since 1834, many of those immigrants first found a home in Corktown. Corktown has always symbolized the heart of the Irish community in Detroit. With the ongoing restoration of Corktown, the idea of a gathering place was developed. During the Tri-Centennial Celebration of Detroit in 2001, the consecration of the land by numerous Clergy took place with over 250 members of the Irish community present.

The (a, λ, a) will be located at Michigan Avenue and 6th Street - the edge of the original Corktown.

You can be a part of the Maza campaign by purchasing a personalized paver, seat, flagpole, or steps.

Your contribution will be a permanent reminder to all, that you, your family, organization, or company acknowledges the contribution the Irish community has made to the City of Detroit and the State of Michigan.

The United Irish Societies (UIS) represents twenty-plus Irish organizations that work together to plan and stage the annual St. Patrick's Parade in Detroit.



The setting for the land owned by the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT). MDOT granted the UIS permission in 2001 to use the property for a commemorative plaza.

The intent is to finance the construction and maintenance through the sale of various elements of the landscape and hardscape. Approximately 2,200 dedication pavers are the primary components of the plan.

There will be three levels of donation - Gold, Silver, and Bronze - based on the proximity to the trefoil dais and three flagpoles in the southeast corner of the plaza. A Bradford Pear tree surrounded by contrasting color pavers and four mushroom-cap shaped seats will delineate each of the areas.

Donation options include clay brick pavers in two sizes: 4" by 8" or 8" by 8"; granite pavers in an 8" by 8" size; granite seats atop the stone wall fronting the planting beds along the John C. Lodge Expressway right of way; three granite and stone steps that lead up to the flagpoles; the flagpoles themselves (United States, Michigan and Ireland); and three pear trees. In addition to the options and pricing on the facing page, future donation opportunities may be made available, ranging from \$1,000 to \$7,500. The Maza will be the starting point for all future St. Patrick's parades. It will also be a lasting memorial to the ancestors, friends, and organizations which comprise the Irish in Detroit and Southeastern Michigan.
